The two office towers at the Main Station Berlin are each 46 metres tall and tower above the East-West glass roof of the main station like bridges. 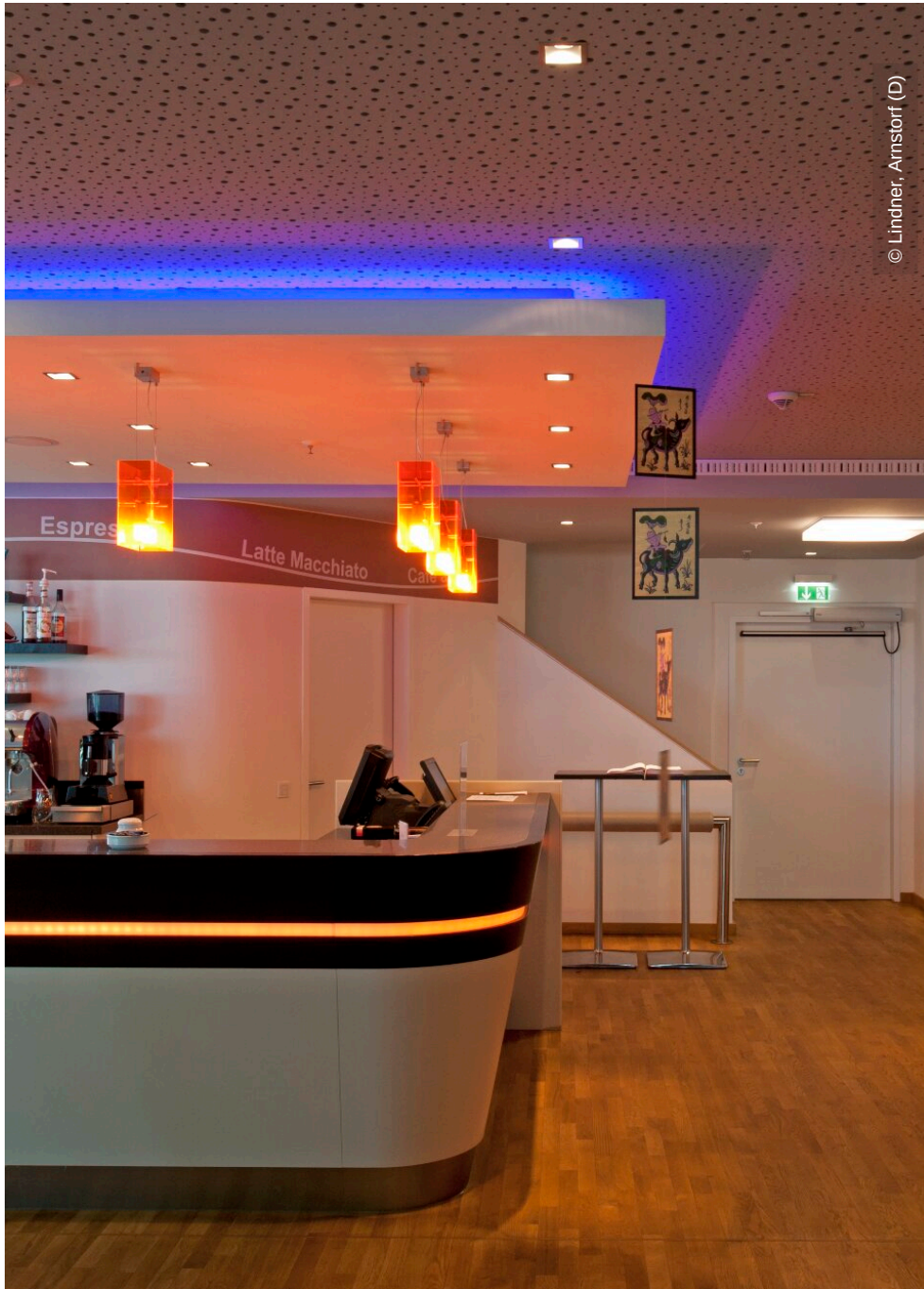

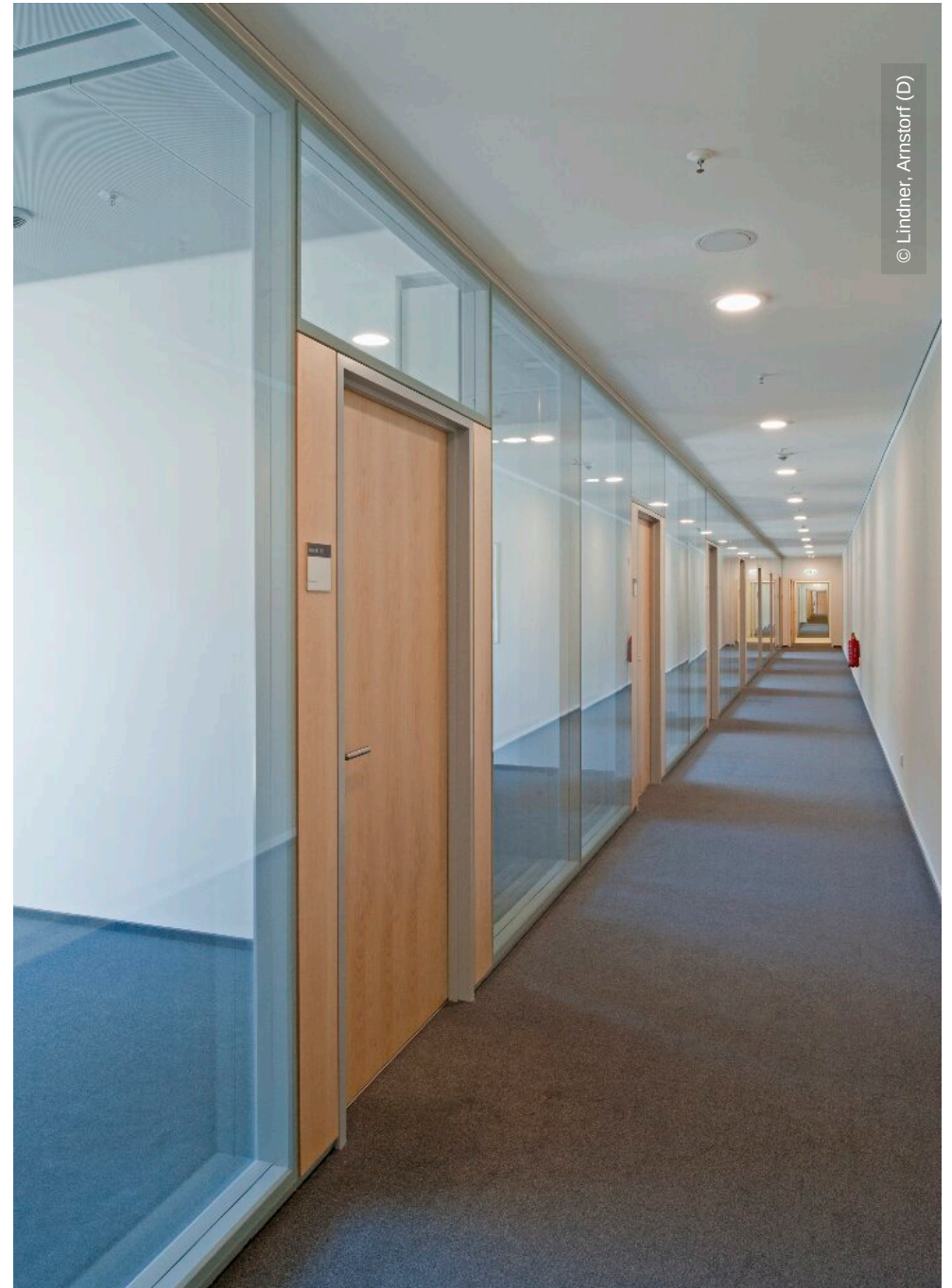
