# Project Description

The leading manufacturer of electric actuators is consolidating its international activities within this modern new building, creating an inspiring workspace for around 220 employees across 11,500 m<sup>2</sup> of gross floor area. Clear structures, open communication zones, and spacious office areas foster collaborative workflows and creative exchange between different company departments. Generous glass facades allow for plenty of natural light, while organically shaped wooden elements add natural accents.

Another key design feature that significantly enhances the overall quality of the space is the large-format heating and cooling ceilings from the Lindner Group.

The suspended ceiling system, Plafotherm® E 200, ensures a pleasant indoor climate through radiant heating and cooling while offering impressive energy efficiency. Installed as island solutions, the large, curved ceiling panels in a simple white finish feature an open shadow gap around the edges, lending the rooms an airy and light atmosphere. The system is further complemented by a central multifunctional channel that integrates lighting and technical installations.

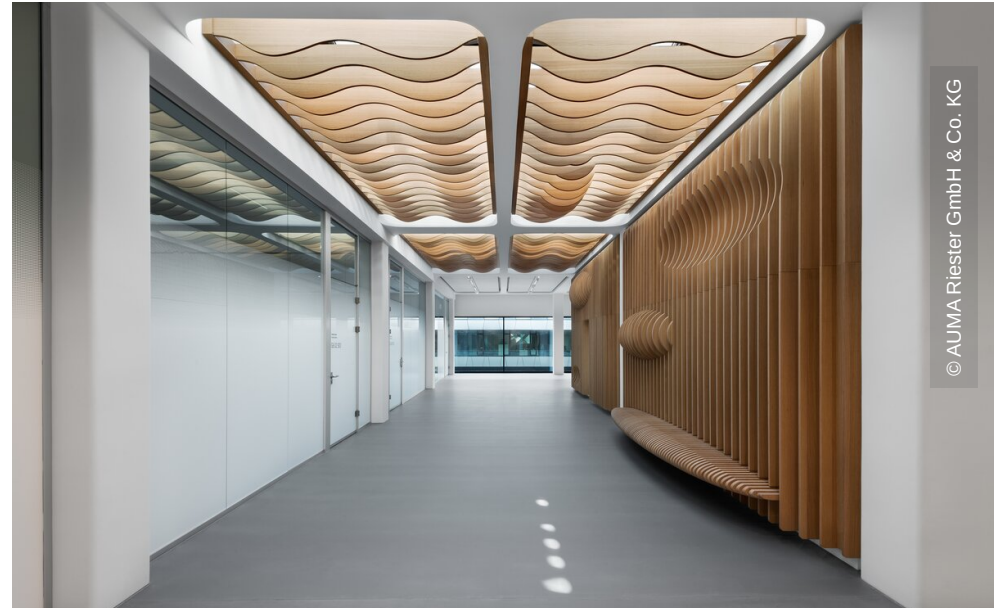
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
