GERMAN CONSULATE GENERAL

YEKATERINBURG, RUSSIA



Description:

Lindner was the general planner for the interior construction of the German Consulate General in Yekaterinburg in the Ural area. During normal operations, new office and administration areas were planned and implemented on level 28 of the Skyscraper, which is the second highest in Russia (excluding Moscow). Special emphasis was attached to a uniform design and to the conception of new solutions for the office areas. Several single offices and an open-plan office with a sophisticated lighting concept and a comfortable colour scheme were implemented. Lindner was not only responsible for the general planning, but also implemented raised floors and partition walls on level 28 of the Vysotskys Business Center.
